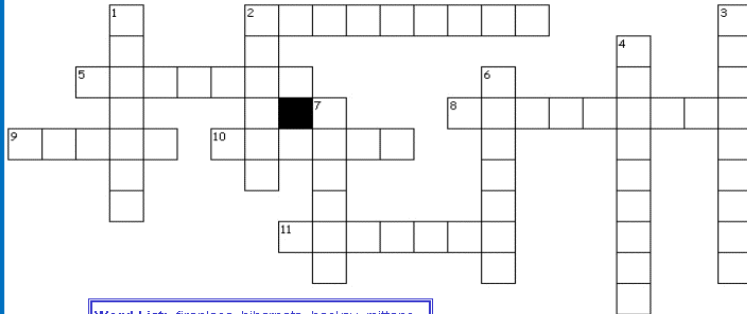

Winter Crossword



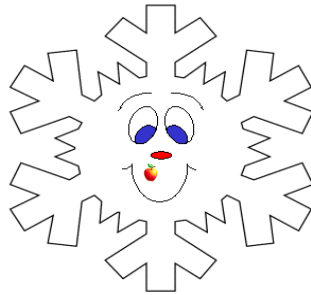
Word List: fireplace, hibernate, hockey, mittens, penguin, polarbear, skidoo, skiing, snowflake, snowman, sweater, white

All you need is peanut butter, a bread slice, a banana, raisins, and some grapes.



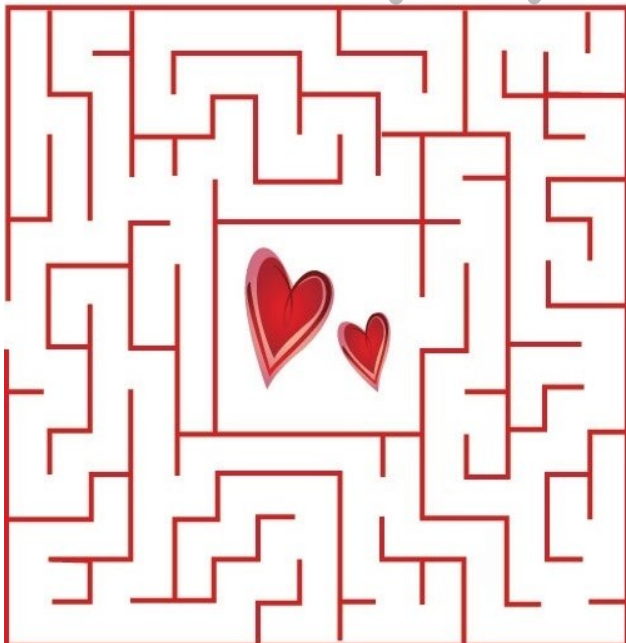
1. Spread the peanut butter onto the bread.

Valentine's Day Maze

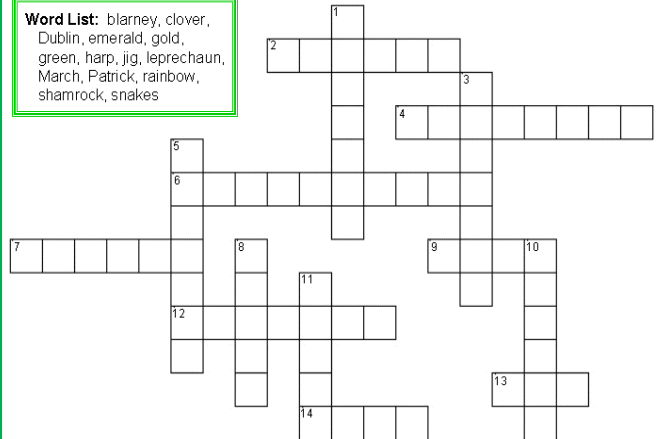


Groundhog Day Facts
