Qualifications:

- 1) Recipient must be a senior graduating from Michigan City High School in the spring of 2020.
- 2) Recipient must be planning to pursue a Bachelor's Degree in the field of Education.

This scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- A. **Recipient must be a member of First Trust Credit Union – if not a current member, applicant may open an account at any local branch location. (Bring photo I.D. and social security card, and parent/guardian if under 18 years of age.)**
- B. Enrollment in an accredited institution for post high school education or training.
- C. Scholastic achievement
- D. Involvement in school and community activities
- E. Essay from applicant
- F. Letter of recommendation from a teacher/educator
