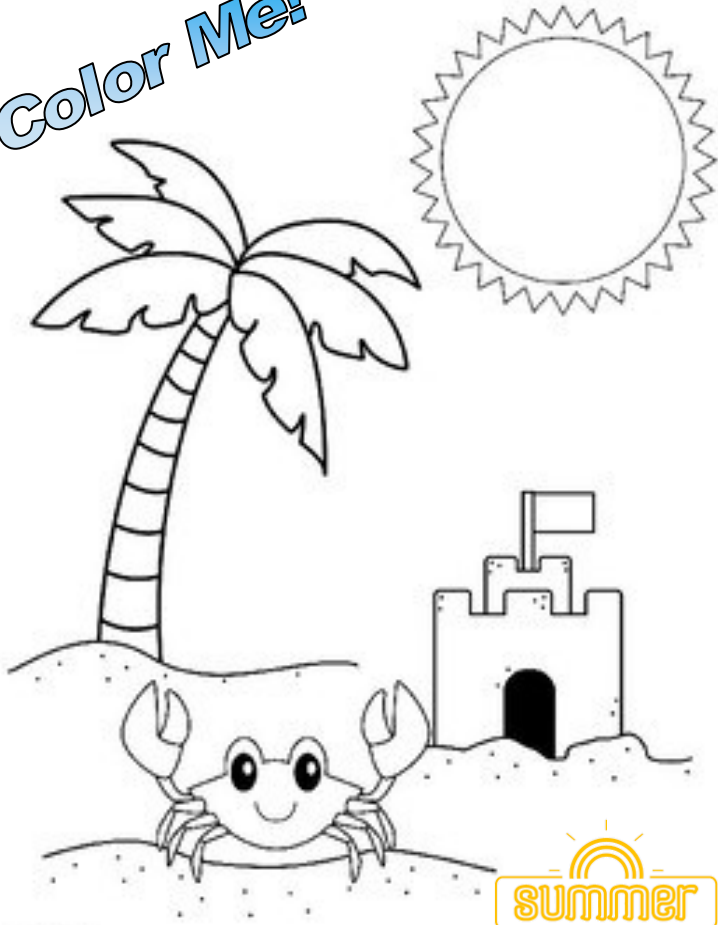

What you will need:

1. A jar with a lid
2. Hairspray
3. About 1/3 cup hot water
4. Ice cubes

Do you like looking at clouds in the sky? Follow the instructions below to make your own clouds!

1. Have an adult help you pour hot water into the jar. Swirl it around to warm up the sides of the jar.
2. Turn the lid upside down and place it on top of the jar. Place several ice cubes onto the lid, and allow it to rest on the top of the jar for about 20 seconds.
3. Remove the lid, quickly spray some hairspray into the jar, and replace the lid with the ice still on top.
4. WATCH THE CLOUDS FORM!

Coin Sorting



Activities
