#### PROTECT YOUR IDENTITY - DON'T BE A VICTIM! Fraud is becoming more prevalent and COVID-19 has opened up a whole new world to fraudsters. Protect your identity and don't become a victim of financial scams.

We have all heard of, or unfortunately experienced financial scams. Some of the typical scenarios to watch out for are romance scams, email or text messages with unexpected attachments, and phone calls asking for any type of personal information. Tom Dougherty, Investments & Fraud Manager for First Trust Credit Union, says, "Members need to be suspicious of calls that appear to be coming from First Trust CU asking for debit card and pin information, as fraudsters can "spoof" a financial institution's phone number." (This means the number showing on the caller-ID is actually the financial institution's phone number but the call *isn't coming from that credit union/bank.*) He continued, "They will call a member stating that they are a representative from First Trust Credit Union and they are investigating fraudulent charges on the member's debit card. They tell the member that they can take care of everything over the phone and that the member cannot come into the credit union because our offices are still closed due to the COVID-19 Pandemic (this is false - our lobbies are open)." A sense of urgency is many times required in fraudulent activity - a person will be told they have to take care of the situation immediately to avoid legal action, fines & penalties, or even to avoid being arrested. Dougherty says the best thing to do if you suspect ANYTHING is to hang up the phone and call the credit union to see if the phone call is legitimate, and NEVER give someone your personal information over the phone, or via email, text, or social media including your debit card number, pin number, passwords, social security number, birthdate, etc. If you do feel your account could have been compromised, call your financial institution immediately to report it.
