TIPS FOR SETTING UP AN EMERGENCY FUND Open a First Trust Rainy Day Account

Have you ever thought about setting up an Emergency Fund? The rule of thumb suggests having at least 3-6 months of your

yearly income set aside to pay for emergency expenses that can pop up in life when you least expect it. These expenses, to name a few, can include car repairs, household appliances breaking down, or unexpected medical bills. First Trust Credit Union offers members a great way to get started by opening a Rainy Day savings account with no minimum balance requirement. This account is a sub-account to your regular savings, and you can deposit and withdraw funds at any time. You can even have direct deposit set up for a portion of funds, that you designate, to be deposited from your paycheck, or to be automatically transferred from your other First Trust accounts on a regular basis. Putting aside a small amount of money consistently can add up fast, and you may be pleasantly surprised at how quickly your emergency fund will grow. Here are some other helpful tips and strategies to help you build an emergency fund for a *rainy day*:

- 1. Work on preparing a budget and commit to sticking to it.
- 2. Determine a specific amount of money you want to set aside each month.
- 3. Start with small savings goals. Increase them if/when you feel comfortable.
- 4. Anytime you receive extra money (pay increase, bonus, tax refund, etc.) devote at least some of it to your emergency fund.
- 5. Look at your regular spending habits. Reallocate frivolous spending and add it to your emergency fund when your fund reaches your goal, reward yourself with a fun purchase or activity.
- 6. Try the *out of sight, out of mind* mentality. In other words, once you put money into the emergency fund forget it's there and your savings will grow quickly. Remember that money you don't have, or have access to, is money you won't spend.
- 7. If trying to save for an emergency becomes overwhelming, try to scale back to a couple small steps and take it slow. Any amount of money set aside is better than having no money set aside at all.
