While old guidelines are still helpful such as including both capital and lowercase letters, numbers, and punctuation, the NIST stressed using longer, stronger passwords such as "passphrases". Here is an example:

Ilikegreatrates!

- iLike6reatRAte\$! (even stronger)

Never use just your birthdate, address, or other personal information that is easy to access/hack. Pay close attention to strongly protecting your email accounts, as hackers who can access your email can potentially take over all your other accounts. BE SAFE!
