This scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- A. **Recipient must be a member of First Trust Credit Union – if not a current member, applicant may open an account at any local branch location. (Bring photo I.D. and social security card, and parent/guardian if under 18 years of age.)**
- B. Graduation from an accredited high school and entering the initial year of post high school education in pursuit of a four-year degree.
- C. Enrollment in an accredited institution for post high school education or training.
- D. Scholastic achievement
- E. Involvement in school and community activities
- F. Essay from applicant
- G. Letter of recommendation from a teacher
