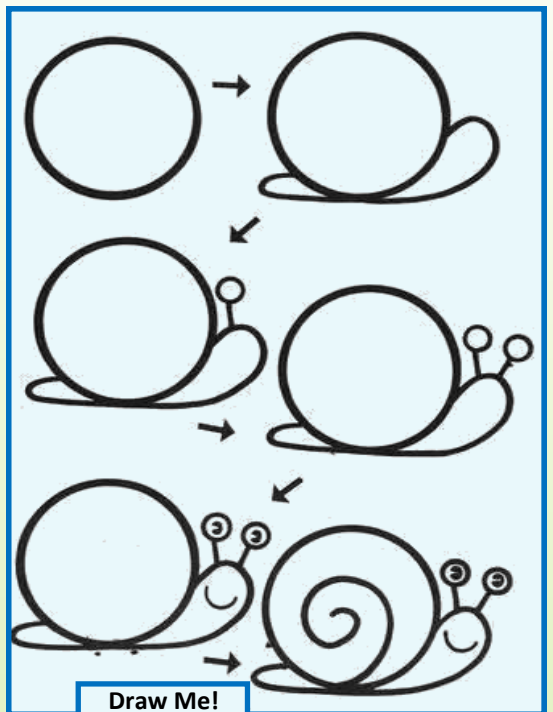

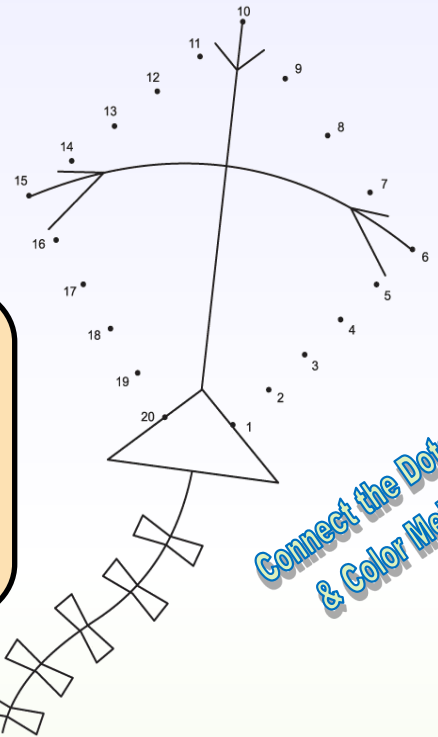

You Need: round crackers, marshmallows, red & blue fruit roll-ups, white frosting, white star sprinkles (optional).



MEMORIAL DAY PATRIOTIC TOP HATS

DIRECTIONS:



1. Unwrap & unroll the fruit roll-ups so they are laying flat.
2. Cut circles from the red fruit roll-up to fit the top of the cracker and the top of the marshmallow. Secure them with the white frosting if needed.
3. Secure the marshmallow in the center of the cracker with a little bit of the white frosting.
4. Cut the fruit roll-ups into size-appropriate strips to create the stripes on the hat.
5. Attach the white star sprinkles to the blue stripe around the hat. You can also use just small dots of the white frosting if you don't have star-shaped sprinkles.

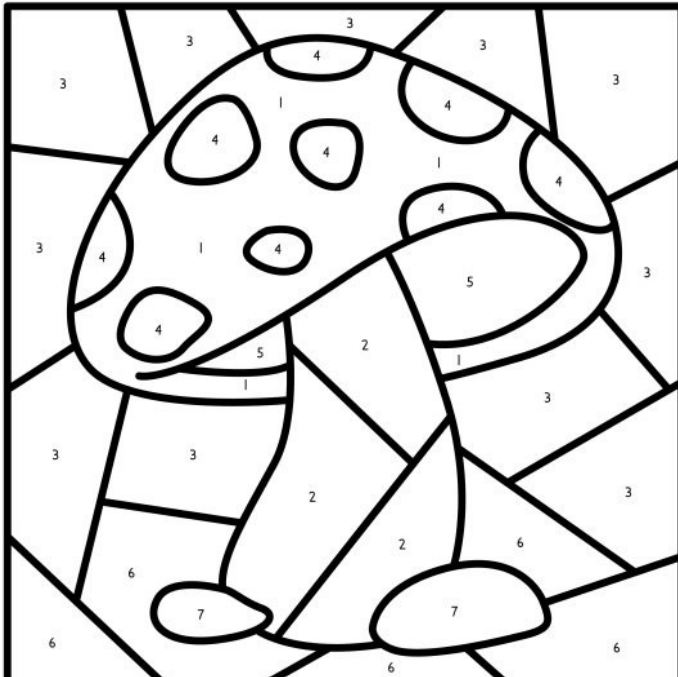
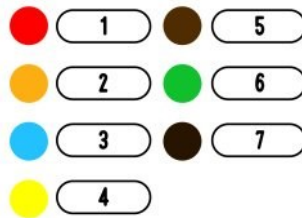
(You can also get creative and substitute round cookies for the crackers, and melted white chocolate for the frosting.) YUM!
